RAVEN CHACON | SOLO 3RD FLOOR | 11 PM

Solo utilizes field recordings collected by artist Raven Chacon at the 2016 Standing Rock gathering and combines them with sounds of acoustic handmade instruments overdriven through electric systems. Originally from the Navajo Nation, Chacon is a composer of chamber music, a performer of experimental noise music and an installation artist, living and working in Albuquerque, New Mexico.
